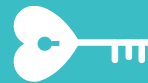

# Super Star Summer Camp



## Tutor position:

Tutors provide instruction Monday - Thursday from 8:15am - 1:00pm We offer 1-1 or small group opportunities for families.

- All tutors are required to complete planning for daily lessons
- All tutors plan for students' daily rehearsal hall sessions:
  - This includes: worksheet(s) related tutoring concepts, fluency passages and general reading (purpose for book reading, or reading games).
    - We provide access to lesson plans and worksheets via the Y-OG training
    - We have subscriptions to a variety of reading and fluency passages the share with students in addition to printed books.
- Each tutor will be the leader for at least one Funday Friday - this typically works best as a team. We work together to create fun activities for the campers.
- Weekly meetings to discuss student goals and objectives are required to be determined by the location team.
- Assessment team opportunities: if that is something you enjoy.
- Pre-camp training and set up takes place the week before camp.
  - Tutors review the Y-OG training, which will include providing access to all of the resources we have to offer.
  - *Set-up day we will also plan the first couple of days of lessons and detail rehearsal hall planning.*
- Reporting of Progress and Conferencing with families takes place in the last week of camp. We have a report template that can be personalized and data from pre- and end-of-camp assessments is outlined in those reports.

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## STEAM Teacher Position:

STEAM Teachers provide instruction Monday - Thursday from 8:15am - 1:00pm

- STEAM/Entrepreneurship:

STEAM is an educational approach that focuses on Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics.

Students are free to wonder, investigate, explore, discuss, design, and “think outside the box.”

Each week there will be a new area of STEAM; including, science, technology, engineering, entrepreneurship, and art where the Super Star campers will complete various hands-on projects.

**Once the lessons are planned the STEAM teachers may need to purchase the components of the lesson. (We pay for all materials)**

- Our STEAM teams from all locations collaborate to organize, plan and coordinate daily STEAM sessions. Sessions take place 4 hours daily Monday - Thursday.
- STEAM teachers also participate in leading Friday Fridays.
- STEAM Teachers report an overview of each STEAM session and the goals of learning as part of each camper’s final report.

**This is inclusive and hands on learning - less talking and more doing!**

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## Rehearsal Hall Helper Position:

Monday - Thursday from 8:00am - 1:00pm

Rehearsal Hall Helpers are compassionate, self-motivated staff members who come alongside campers and guide them through the day.

- Rehearsal Hall

Create safe camp community

Guide students to understand tasks, support campers to succeed in their learning goals, participate in oral reading, assist in managing a clean, well-stocked work space, and monitor student safety

- Movement Breaks

Monitor student safety

Engage with campers through play and conversation

Assist in transitions between rooms and sessions on schedule

- Weekly Meetings

Communicate student success to Site Directors

Communicate student concerns to Site Directors

Collaborate in team discussions and conversations to include: Funday Friday logistics, provide feedback to tutors about rehearsal hall assignments, share uplifting strategies with the team, and provide feedback on student interactions.

- STEAM Sessions

Attend to all directions from STEAM Teacher

Assist as directed by STEAM teacher

Encourage teamwork and positive community during activities

Assist Funday Friday Tutors with special activities. Engage with campers. HAVE FUN!
